

CHAPTER 724

(House Bill 1406)

AN ACT concerning

Business and Economic Development – Maryland Public Art Initiative – Sunset Repeal

FOR the purpose of repealing the termination provision applicable to the Maryland Public Art Initiative Program, the Maryland Public Art Fund, and the Maryland Commission on Public Art within the Department of Business and Economic Development; and generally relating to the Maryland Public Art Initiative Program, the Maryland Public Art Fund, and the Maryland Commission on Public Art.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Chapter 393 of the Acts of 2005

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2005. [It shall remain effective for a period of 5 years and, at the end of May 31, 2010, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.]

Chapter 306 of the Acts of 2008

[SECTION 21. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Title 4, Subtitle 6, of the Economic Development Article and the subtitle “Subtitle 6. Maryland Public Art Initiative Program” as enacted by Section 2 of this Act, shall remain effective until the taking effect of the termination provision specified in Section 2 of Chapter 393 of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2005. If that termination provision takes effect, Title 4, Subtitle 6 of the Economic Development Article and the subtitle “Subtitle 6. Maryland Public Art Initiative Program”, as enacted by Section 2 of this Act, shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect. This Act may not be interpreted to have any effect on that termination provision.]

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2009.
