**Economic Matters** 

### St. Mary's County - Alcoholic Beverages - Off-Sale License Quota

This bill requires the St. Mary's County Board of License Commissioners to issue no more than one alcoholic beverages license with an off-sale privilege, regardless of license class, for each unit of 4,000 people in each election district in the county. The license quota must be maintained using the population figures of the most recent federal census.

The bill takes effect July 1, 2009 and applies only prospectively.

# **Fiscal Summary**

**Background:** There are currently 163 licensees with an off-sale privilege in St. Mary's County. According to the 2000 Census, the population of St. Mary's County is 86,211.
