Budget and Taxation

Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2006, 2007, and 2008 - Anne Arundel County - Annapolis Underground Wiring

This bill requires that the construction and equipping of underground utilities – in Annapolis as specified by the Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2006, 2007, and 2008 – be located on Cornhill, Fleet, and Pinkney Streets.

The bill takes effect June 1, 2009.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The bill does not directly affect governmental operations or finances.

Local Effect: The bill does not directly affect the finances or operations of Anne Arundel County or the City of Annapolis.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Maryland Consolidated Capital Bond Loans of 2006, 2007, and 2008 each authorize up to \$600,000 in matching funds to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Annapolis to assist in the construction and installation of underground wiring in the city. The loans do not identify specific locations or streets for these projects.
