FISCAL AND POLICY NOTE

House Bill 69 (Delegates Feldman and Manno)

Economic Matters Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs

Business Occupations and Professions - Accountants - Continuing Education

This bill repeals the provision that restricts certified public accountants to meeting no more than 40 hours of the continuing education requirement for license renewal through a course of home study or service as a teacher, lecturer, or discussion leader.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: The change is procedural in nature and does not directly affect governmental finances.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The State Board of Public Accountancy establishes continuing education requirements that a certified public accountant must fulfill in order to renew his or her license every two years. The continuing education requirement does not apply to the first renewal of a license. For subsequent renewals, licensees must complete at least 80 hours in programs approved by the board for each two-year license term. No more than 40 of these hours may be met through participation in a course of home study or service as a teacher, lecturer, or discussion leader in a board-approved course.
