(Prince George's County Delegation)

Prince George's County - 47th Alcoholic Beverages District - Class A (Off-Sale)
Licensees - Minimum Container Size for Chilled Beer
PG 303-09

This bill prohibits a holder of a Class A beer license; beer and light wine license; or beer, wine, and liquor license from selling chilled beer in an individual container with a capacity of less than one gallon in the 47<sup>th</sup> alcoholic beverages district of Prince George's County.

### **Fiscal Summary**

State Effect: None. The bill does not materially affect State alcohol tax revenues.

Local Effect: None. Enforcement activities can be handled with existing resources.

**Small Business Effect:** Potential meaningful impact for small businesses in the 47<sup>th</sup> alcoholic beverages district that can no longer sell certain products due to the bill's restrictions.

## **Analysis**

**Current Law:** There are no restrictions exclusively on the sale of chilled beer in any district in Prince George's County.

**Background:** According to the *State of Maryland Alcohol and Tobacco Tax Annual Report*, approximately 13.4 million gallons of beer were delivered to Prince George's County in fiscal 2008.
