AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 310

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after "waiver;" insert "requiring the State Superintendent to provide a certain preliminary assessment to the State Board of Education;"; in line 9, after "denied;" insert "requiring the Maryland State Department of Education to report to the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the application of this Act;"; and in line 10, after "measure;" insert "providing for the termination of this Act;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 14, strike "MAY 1" and substitute "APRIL 20"; after line 14, insert:

"(III) THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT SHALL PROVIDE A
PRELIMINARY ASSESSMENT OF A WAIVER APPLICATION TO THE STATE BOARD
PRIOR TO ANY PUBLIC HEARING UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (IV) OF THIS
PARAGRAPH.";

and in lines 15 and 18, strike "(III)" and "(IV)", respectively, and substitute "(IV)" and "(V)", respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in lines 7 and 11, strike "(V)" and "(VI)", respectively, and substitute "(VI)" and "(VII)", respectively; in line 9, strike "45" and substitute "30"; in line 10, strike "JUNE 1" and substitute "MAY 20"; after line 16, insert:

"SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to all waiver applications beginning with applications for waivers for fiscal year 2011.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before December 1, 2012, the Maryland State Department of Education shall report to the House Ways and Means Committee and the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the implementation of this Act.";

in line 17, strike "2." and substitute "<u>4.</u>"; and in line 21, after "enacted." insert "<u>It shall</u> remain effective through June 30, 2013, and, at the end of June 30, 2013, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
