## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 20 on page 1 through line 24 on page 2, inclusive, and substitute:

## "<u>Article – Transportation</u>

## <u>21–901.1.</u>

- (a) A person is guilty of reckless driving if he drives a motor vehicle:
- (1) <u>In wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property;</u> or
- (2) <u>In a manner that indicates a wanton or willful disregard for the safety of persons or property.</u>
- (b) A person is guilty of negligent driving if he drives a motor vehicle in a careless or imprudent manner that endangers any property or the life or person of any individual.

## 27-101.

- (g) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the following sections of this article is subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000:
- (3) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (DD) OF THIS SECTION, § 21-901.1(a) ("Reckless driving").
- (DD) ANY PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF A VIOLATION OF § 21-901.1(A) OF THIS ARTICLE ("RECKLESS DRIVING") THAT RESULTS IN DEATH IS SUBJECT
