### AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 21

(First Reading File Bill)

## AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "and Raskin" and substitute "<u>Raskin</u>, Forehand, and Stone".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 5, strike "the future ownership of an animal" and substitute "owning, possessing, or residing with an animal for the life of the defendant or for a specified period of time; providing that a certain violation of a condition of sentencing subjects the violator to removal of the animal at the expense of the violator and may be treated as criminal contempt".

# AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 12, strike "FUTURE OWNERSHIP OF AN ANIMAL" and substitute "OWNING, POSSESSING, OR RESIDING WITH AN ANIMAL FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME"; after line 12, insert:

- "(3) A VIOLATION OF A CONDITION OF SENTENCING UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- (I) SUBJECTS THE VIOLATOR TO REMOVAL OF THE ANIMAL AT THE EXPENSE OF THE VIOLATOR; AND
- (II) MAY BE TREATED AS A CRIMINAL CONTEMPT PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.";

in line 28, strike "FUTURE OWNERSHIP OF AN ANIMAL" and substitute "OWNING, POSSESSING, OR RESIDING WITH AN ANIMAL FOR THE LIFE OF THE DEFENDANT OR FOR A SPECIFIED PERIOD OF TIME"; and after line 28, insert:

- "(3) A VIOLATION OF A CONDITION OF SENTENCING UNDER PARAGRAPH (2)(II) OF THIS SUBSECTION:
- (I) SUBJECTS THE VIOLATOR TO REMOVAL OF THE ANIMAL AT THE EXPENSE OF THE VIOLATOR; AND
- (II) MAY BE TREATED AS A CRIMINAL CONTEMPT PUNISHABLE AS PROVIDED BY LAW.".
