(b) This section does not apply to the use of a wireless communication device to contact:

### (1) [a] A 9–1–1 system; OR

# (2) <u>A PARENT UNLESS THE WIRELESS COMMUNICATION DEVICE</u> <u>IS A TEXT MESSAGING DEVICE.</u>

(c) <u>A holder of a learner's instructional permit or a provisional driver's</u> <u>license who is under the age of 18 years may not use a wireless communication device</u> <u>while operating a motor vehicle.</u>

(d) <u>A police officer may enforce this section only as a secondary action when</u> the police officer detains a driver for a suspected violation of another provision of the <u>Code.</u>

(e) (1) If the Administration receives satisfactory evidence that an individual has violated this section, the Administration:

(i) May suspend the individual's driver's license for not more than 90 days; and

(ii) <u>May issue a restricted license for the period of suspension</u> that is limited to driving a motor vehicle:

<u>1.</u> <u>In the course of the individual's employment;</u>

2. For the purpose of driving to or from a place of

employment; or

<u>3.</u> For the purpose of driving to or from school.

(2) <u>An individual may request a hearing as provided for a suspension</u> <u>or revocation under Title 12, Subtitle 2 of this article.</u>".
