AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 16, strike "<u>submitting for recording</u>" and substitute "<u>including certain personal information in</u>"; in line 17, strike "<u>that contain certain personal information</u>"; and in the same line, after the semicolon, insert "<u>authorizing certain persons to delete certain information or request that certain information be masked from certain deeds and other recordable instruments; specifying that certain persons are immune from civil liability or criminal penalty for certain acts under certain circumstances;".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 7, strike beginning with "<u>SUBMIT</u>" in line 9 down through "<u>RECORDING</u>" in line 10 and substitute "<u>INCLUDE PERSONAL INFORMATION IN</u>"; strike beginning with "<u>THAT</u>" in line 10 down through "<u>INFORMATION</u>" in line 11 and substitute "<u>INTENDED FOR RECORDING</u>"; after line 11, insert:

- "(C) A PERSON ENGAGED TO PERFORM OR CHARGED WITH THE DUTY TO RECORD A DEED OR OTHER RECORDABLE INSTRUMENT THAT CONTAINS PERSONAL INFORMATION MAY, PRIOR TO RECORDING:
- (1) PERMANENTLY DELETE THE PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM THE DEED OR OTHER RECORDABLE INSTRUMENT; OR
- (2) REQUEST THAT THE PERSONAL INFORMATION BE MASKED FROM THE DEED OR OTHER RECORDABLE INSTRUMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 8-504 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.

- (D) A PERSON IS IMMUNE FROM CIVIL LIABILITY OR CRIMINAL PENALTY IF THE PERSON:
- (1) INADVERTENTLY RECORDS A DEED OR OTHER RECORDABLE INSTRUMENT CONTAINING PERSONAL INFORMATION; OR
- (2) DELETES OR MASKS PERSONAL INFORMATION FROM A DEED OR OTHER RECORDABLE INSTRUMENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION.";

and in line 12, strike "(C)" and substitute "(E)".
