AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments (HB0943/900518/1), in line 9 of Amendment No. 1, after "<u>requirements</u>;" insert "<u>requiring the Trust to conduct a certain gap analysis for a certain purpose; requiring the gap analysis to establish a certain baseline to be used to make a certain comparison on the impacts of the Corps Program on certain existing volunteer conservation organizations and programs; requiring the Trust to submit an annual report to the Governor and the General Assembly;".</u>

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 9 of the Environmental Matters Committee Amendments, in line 12 of Amendment No. 5, after "<u>PLANNED.</u>" insert:

"(E) (1) THE TRUST SHALL CONDUCT A GAP ANALYSIS IN ORDER TO COMPARE THE POTENTIAL CONTRIBUTIONS OF THE CORPS PROGRAM WITH EXISTING VOLUNTEER CONSERVATION ORGANIZATIONS AND PROGRAMS IN THE STATE.

(2) <u>THE GAP ANALYSIS SHALL:</u>

(I) ESTABLISH A BASELINE OF EXISTING VOLUNTEER CONSERVATION ORGANIZATIONS AND PROGRAMS; AND

(II) <u>CONDUCT AN ANNUAL REVIEW TO:</u>

(Over)

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1. <u>COMPARE EMPIRICAL DATA ON ANY COLLATERAL</u> IMPACTS OF THE CORPS PROGRAM ON EXISTING VOLUNTEER CONSERVATION ORGANIZATIONS AND PROGRAMS; AND

2. <u>Assess any overlap or conflict in the</u> <u>Ability of existing volunteer conservation organizations and</u> <u>programs to continue to achieve their goals in competition with the</u> <u>stipend volunteer positions funded through the Corps Program.</u>

(3) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1 OF EACH YEAR, THE TRUST SHALL SUBMIT A REPORT OF ITS FINDINGS TO THE GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.".
