AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 264, AS AMENDED

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0264/324239/1), in line 6 of Amendment No. 1, after “year:” insert “requiring that the Personal Financial Literacy State Curriculum be implemented in a certain manner; requiring the State Board of Education to require successful completion of a certain course to be a requirement for graduation from a high school in this State;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, in line 3 of Amendment No. 2, after “**(B)**” insert “**(1)**”; after line 6, insert:

“(2) THE PERSONAL FINANCIAL LITERACY STATE CURRICULUM SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED AS A SINGLE TOPIC, SEMESTER-LONG COURSE IN PERSONAL FINANCIAL LITERACY IN EVERY HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE.

“(3) THE STATE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE COURSE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SECTION AS A REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION FROM A HIGH SCHOOL IN THIS STATE.”.
