AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments (SB0264/324239/1), in line 6 of Amendment No. 1, after "year;" insert "requiring that the Personal Financial Literacy State Curriculum be implemented in a certain manner; requiring the State Board of Education to require successful completion of a certain course to be a requirement for graduation from a high school in this State;".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee Amendments, in line 3 of Amendment No. 2, after "(B)" insert "(1)"; after line 6, insert:

- "(2) THE PERSONAL FINANCIAL LITERACY STATE CURRICULUM SHALL BE IMPLEMENTED AS A SINGLE TOPIC, SEMESTER-LONG COURSE IN PERSONAL FINANCIAL LITERACY IN EVERY HIGH SCHOOL IN THE STATE.
- (3) THE STATE BOARD SHALL REQUIRE SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THE COURSE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SECTION AS A REQUIREMENT FOR GRADUATION FROM A HIGH SCHOOL IN THIS STATE.".
