AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 834  
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “Senator Currie” and substitute “Senators Currie and Miller”; and strike beginning with “authorizing” in line 5 down through “circumstances” in line 7 and substitute “authorizing the State Board of Education to grant a certain waiver under certain circumstances; requiring certain public charter schools to admit certain students on a certain basis, subject to a certain requirement”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 22 through 25, inclusive; and after line 25, insert:

**“(A) THE STATE BOARD MAY GRANT A WAIVER FROM § 9-102(3) OF THIS TITLE TO A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL IF THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL:**

**(1) IS LOCATED ON PROPERTY WITHIN A FEDERAL MILITARY BASE IN THE STATE; AND**

**(2) WILL ADMIT STUDENTS WITH PARENTS WHO ARE NOT ASSIGNED TO THE BASE TO AT LEAST 30% OF ITS TOTAL AVAILABLE SPACE.**

**(B) IF A PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL IS GRANTED A WAIVER UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, SUBJECT TO THE REQUIREMENT SET FORTH IN SUBSECTION (A)(2) OF THIS SECTION, THE PUBLIC CHARTER SCHOOL SHALL ADMIT ALL STUDENTS ON A LOTTERY BASIS.”**
