On page 1, in line 7, strike "consultation" and substitute "<u>partnership</u>"; in line 10, after "grants" insert "<u>to certain grantees</u>"; in line 11, after "Trust" insert "<u>and Commission</u>"; strike beginning with "before" in line 11 down through "Commission" in line 12 and substitute "<u>and consider certain factors</u>"; in line 13, strike "to approve" and substitute "<u>on or before a certain date, to recommend</u>"; in line 14, after "budget" insert "<u>and forward the recommendations to the Department of Budget and Management</u>"; in line 15, after "Trust" insert "<u>and Commission</u>"; in line 16, after "date;" insert "<u>requiring a grantee under the Program to enter into a certain agreement, unless the requirement is waived by the Secretary of Planning</u>."; in the same line, strike "Trust" and substitute "<u>Secretary, in consultation with the Commission</u>,"; in line 17, after "Program," insert "<u>providing that certain regulations may not be adopted unless approved by the Board of Public Works; requiring the Trust recommended under the Program to the Board of Public Works for approval;"; and in the same line, after "terms;" insert "<u>stating a certain regulations</u>,"; and in the same line, after "terms;" insert "<u>stating a certain intent of the General Assembly;</u>".</u>

"(2) <u>A PROPOSED REGULATION THAT RELATES TO APPROVAL BY</u> <u>THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS OF GRANTS TO BE FINANCED THROUGH THE</u> <u>SALE OF STATE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS MAY NOT BE ADOPTED UNDER</u> <u>PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION UNLESS THE REGULATION IS APPROVED</u> <u>BY THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS.</u> (K) TO THE EXTENT REQUIRED BY REGULATIONS ADOPTED UNDER SUBSECTION (J) OF THIS SECTION, THE TRUST AND THE COMMISSION SHALL SUBMIT TO THE BOARD OF PUBLIC WORKS FOR THE BOARD'S APPROVAL EACH RECOMMENDED AFRICAN AMERICAN HERITAGE PRESERVATION PROGRAM GRANT THAT IS TO BE FINANCED THROUGH THE SALE OF STATE GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS.".
