AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1285

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after “abatement;” insert “providing that certain relief is not available in certain actions for abatement of nuisance that alleges the use of a property for prostitution;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 5, in line 28, after “(2)” insert “**(I) THIS PARAGRAPH DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ACTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS SECTION ALLEGING THE USE OF A PROPERTY FOR PROSTITUTION.**”.

(II)”.

On page 5 in line 31 and on page 6 in line 1, strike “(i)” and “(ii)”, respectively, and substitute “**1.**” and “**2.**”, respectively.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 6, after line 3, insert:

“(3) (I) THIS PARAGRAPH APPLIES ONLY TO AN ACTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS SECTION ALLEGING THE USE OF A PROPERTY FOR PROSTITUTION.

“(II) IF AN OWNER, INCLUDING AN OWNER-OCCUPANT, FAILS TO COMPLY WITH AN ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (G) OF THIS SECTION, AFTER A HEARING, THE COURT MAY ISSUE A CONTEMPT ORDER.”;

(Over)

and in line 4, strike “(3)” and substitute “(4)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 6, in line 22, after “(k)” insert “(1) THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO AN ACTION AGAINST AN OWNER, OTHER THAN AN OWNER-OCCUPANT, BROUGHT UNDER THIS SECTION ALLEGING THE USE OF A PROPERTY FOR PROSTITUTION.”
