AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 5
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Police Training Commission – ” and substitute “Task Force on”; in line 4, after the first “of” insert “establishing a Task Force on SWAT Team Activation and Deployment; providing for the membership, chair, and staff of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the Task Force from receiving certain compensation; authorizing a member of the Task Force to receive reimbursement for certain expenses;”; in lines 6 and 7, in each instance, strike “Police Training Commission” and substitute “Task Force”; in line 8, strike “adopt” and substitute “make recommendations for”; in the same line, after “regulations;” insert “providing for the termination of this Act;”; in line 9, strike “Police Training Commission and” and substitute “Task Force on”; and in the same line, strike “team activation and deployment” and substitute “Team Activation and Deployment”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, strike beginning with “**POLICE**” in line 20 down through “**COMMISSION**” in line 21 and substitute “**TASK FORCE ON SWAT TEAM ACTIVATION AND DEPLOYMENT**”; after line 22, insert:

“(F) (1) THERE IS A TASK FORCE ON SWAT TEAM ACTIVATION AND DEPLOYMENT.

(2) THE TASK FORCE CONSISTS OF THE FOLLOWING MEMBERS:

(I) TWO MEMBERS OF THE SENATE OF MARYLAND, APPOINTED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SENATE;

(II) TWO MEMBERS OF THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES, APPOINTED BY THE SPEAKER OF THE HOUSE;

(III) TWO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC WITH RELEVANT EXPERTISE IN SWAT TEAM ACTIVATION AND DEPLOYMENT, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR;

(IV) FOUR REGIONAL TACTICAL REPRESENTATIVES, SELECTED BY THE MARYLAND STATE LODGE FRATERNAL ORDER OF POLICE;

(V) TWO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR; AND

(VI) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES, OR THE SECRETARY'S DESIGNEE, WHO SHALL SERVE EX OFFICIO.

(3) THE SECRETARY OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES SHALL:

(I) CHAIR THE TASK FORCE; AND

(II) PROVIDE STAFF SUPPORT FOR THE TASK FORCE FROM THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES.

(4) A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE:

(I) MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION AS A MEMBER OF THE TASK FORCE; BUT

(II) IS ENTITLED TO REIMBURSEMENT FOR EXPENSES UNDER THE STANDARD STATE TRAVEL REGULATIONS, AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.;

in line 23, strike “(F)” and substitute “(5)”; in the same line, strike “POLICE TRAINING COMMISSION” and substitute “TASK FORCE”; in lines 24, 26, 28, and 30, strike “(1)”, “(2)”, “(I)”, and “(II)”, respectively, and substitute “(I)”, “(II)”, “1.”, and “2.”, respectively; and in line 26, strike “ADOPT” and substitute “MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR”.

On page 4, in line 1, strike “(III)” and substitute “3.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 17, after “2010.”, insert “It shall remain effective for a period of 4 years and, at the end of June 30, 2014, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
