AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 466 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after "transmission;" insert "<u>prohibiting the Motor Vehicle</u> <u>Administration from charging a fee for the issuance of a certificate of title for an offhighway recreational vehicle;</u>"; strike beginning with "providing" in line 10 down through "purchase" in line 15 and substitute "<u>exempting an off-highway recreational</u> <u>vehicle from a certain excise tax</u>"; in line 21, strike "and" and substitute a comma; in the same line, after "13-102(13)" insert "<u>,13-104.3, and 13-810(a)(26)</u>"; and in line 26, strike "13-809" and substitute "<u>13-810(a)(24) and (25)</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 28, insert:

"<u>13-104.3.</u>

<u>NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE</u> <u>ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A</u> <u>CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR AN OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE.</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 5 through 8, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 5 on page 5 through line 13 on page 8, inclusive, and substitute:

"<u>13–810.</u>

(a) On issuance in this State of an original or subsequent certificate of title for a vehicle, the vehicle is exempt from the excise tax imposed by this part, if it is:

(Over)

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(24) <u>A vehicle acquired by a religious, charitable, or volunteer</u> organization exempt from taxation under § 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, the Department of Human Resources, or a local department of social services for the purpose of transferring the vehicle to a Family Investment Program recipient or an individual certified by the Department of Human Resources or a local department of social services as eligible for the transfer; [or]

(25) <u>A rental vehicle[.]; OR</u>

(26) AN OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE.".
