AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL 466
(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 8, after “transmission;” insert “prohibiting the Motor Vehicle Administration from charging a fee for the issuance of a certificate of title for an off-highway recreational vehicle;”; strike beginning with “providing” in line 10 down through “purchase” in line 15 and substitute “exempting an off-highway recreational vehicle from a certain excise tax”; in line 21, strike “and” and substitute a comma; in the same line, after “13-102(13)” insert “,13-104.3, and 13-810(a)(26)”; and in line 26, strike “13-809” and substitute “13-810(a)(24) and (25)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 28, insert:

“13-104.3.

NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF LAW, THE ADMINISTRATION MAY NOT CHARGE A FEE FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A CERTIFICATE OF TITLE FOR AN OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On pages 5 through 8, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 5 on page 5 through line 13 on page 8, inclusive, and substitute:

“13-810.

(a) On issuance in this State of an original or subsequent certificate of title for a vehicle, the vehicle is exempt from the excise tax imposed by this part, if it is:

(Over)

(24) A vehicle acquired by a religious, charitable, or volunteer organization exempt from taxation under § 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code, the Department of Human Resources, or a local department of social services for the purpose of transferring the vehicle to a Family Investment Program recipient or an individual certified by the Department of Human Resources or a local department of social services as eligible for the transfer; [or]

(25) A rental vehicle[.]; OR

(26) AN OFF-HIGHWAY RECREATIONAL VEHICLE.”.
