AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 289

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Walkup” and substitute “Walkup, McDonough, Ali, Anderson, Barnes, Bartlett, Beidle, Bohanan, Burns, Cane, G. Clagett, Conway, Donoghue, Elliott, Feldman, Frush, Harrison, Healey, Impallaria, Ivey, Jameson, Jenkins, Kaiser, King, Kipke, Krysiak, Kullen, Levi, Levy, Love, Malone, Manno, McConkey, Montgomery, Murphy, Myers, Nathan-Pulliam, Niemann, O’Donnell, Oaks, Pena-Melnyk, Ramirez, Reznik, Robinson, Rudolph, Stein, Stifler, Stukes, Tarrant, Taylor, Vaughn, Waldstreicher, and Wood”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, strike beginning with “and” in line 2 down through “Parole” in line 3; in line 6, strike “minor” and substitute “victim who is a child under a certain age”; strike beginning with “providing” in line 7 down through “sentence” in line 9 and substitute “providing for the construction of a certain provision of this Act”; in line 11, strike “and parole eligibility”; and strike in their entirety lines 18 through 22, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in lines 9 and 24, in each instance, strike “MINOR”; in the same lines, in each instance, after “VICTIM” insert “WHO IS A CHILD UNDER THE AGE OF 16 YEARS”; strike in their entirety lines 11 through 16, inclusive; in line 22, after “(B)” insert “(1)”; and after line 27, insert:

“(2) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT BE CONSTRUED TO REQUIRE AN INMATE TO SERVE A LONGER SENTENCE OF CONFINEMENT THAN IS AUTHORIZED BY THE STATUTE UNDER WHICH THE INMATE WAS CONVICTED.”
