6 7 8 9 10	(d) (1) In this subsection, "owner" includes any type of owner of beneficiary of a business entity, including an officer, director, principal employee partner, investor, stockholder, or beneficial owner of the business entity and notwithstanding any other provisions of this subtitle, including a person having any ownership interest regardless of the percentage of ownership interest.
11 12	(2) An individual or business entity may not own an interest in more than one video lottery facility.
13 14	(3) A member of the Senate of Maryland or the House of Delegates may not:
15 16	(I) be an owner or an employee of any business entity that holds a video lottery operation license;
