1 AN ACT concerning

- 2 Public Service Companies Termination of Electric or Gas Service Notice
- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a public service company from terminating electric or 4 gas service to a residential customer because of nonpayment without providing 5 certain notice related to certain bill assistance programs; prohibiting a public 6 service company from terminating electric or gas service to a residential 7 customer over a certain age because of nonpayment without providing certain 8 notice related to certain bill assistance programs; requiring the notices to meet certain requirements; providing for the construction of this Act; requiring the 9 10 Public Service Commission to adopt regulations to carry out this Act; and generally relating to public service companies and the termination of gas or 11 12 electric service to residential customers.

- 24 WITHOUT FIRST NOTIFYING THE CUSTOMER IN WRITING OF STATE BILL
- 25 ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS.

1	(B) IN ADDITION TO THE NOTICE REQUIRED IN SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS
2	SECTION, A PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANY MAY NOT TERMINATE ELECTRIC OR GAS
3	SERVICE TO A RESIDENTIAL CUSTOMER AT LEAST 65 YEARS OF AGE BECAUSE OF
4	NONPAYMENT WITHOUT FIRST NOTIFYING THE CUSTOMER IN WRITING OF BILL
5	ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS AVAILABLE IN THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE CUSTOMER

- 7 (C) THE NOTICES REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTIONS (A) AND (B) OF THIS 8 SECTION SHALL:
- 9 (1) BE DESIGNED TO GIVE THE CUSTOMER THE OPPORTUNITY TO
 10 APPLY FOR AND RECEIVE BILL ASSISTANCE IN TIME TO AVOID TERMINATION OF
 11 SERVICE; AND
- 12 **(2)** EXPLAIN HOW TO OBTAIN MORE INFORMATION ABOUT EACH 13 BILL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- 14 (D) THIS SECTION DOES NOT LIMIT THE AUTHORITY OF THE
 15 COMMISSION TO ADOPT, BY REGULATION OR ORDER, ADDITIONAL LIMITATIONS
 16 AND CONDITIONS ON TERMINATION OF ELECTRIC OR GAS SERVICE THAT ARE
 17 MORE PROTECTIVE OF CONSUMERS.
- 18 **(E)** THE COMMISSION SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 19 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
