### 1 AN ACT concerning

# 2 Automobile Insurance – Use of Territory in Rate Making – Limitation

- FOR the purpose of limiting the number of territories an insurer may use in establishing automobile insurance rates under provisions of law governing prior approval rate making and competitive rating; requiring the Maryland Insurance Commissioner to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to rate making for automobile insurance policies.

# 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 15 Article Insurance
- 16 11–216.

17 (A) An insurer that uses territory as a factor in establishing automobile 18 insurance rates:

19(1) MAY NOT USE MORE THAN THREE TERRITORIES, AS20ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSIONER BY REGULATION, IN ESTABLISHING21AUTOMOBILE INSURANCE RATES; AND
