12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article – State Government

16 (A) IN RECOGNITION OF THE CONTRIBUTIONS THAT HISPANIC 17 AMERICANS HAVE MADE TO THE STATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL PROCLAIM THE 18 MONTH FROM SEPTEMBER 15 TO OCTOBER 15, BOTH INCLUSIVE, EACH YEAR AS 19 HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH.

20 (B) THE PROCLAMATION SHALL URGE EDUCATIONAL AND CULTURAL 21 ORGANIZATIONS TO OBSERVE HISPANIC HERITAGE MONTH PROPERLY WITH 22 APPROPRIATE PROGRAMS, CEREMONIES, AND ACTIVITIES.

1 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 July 1, 2010.
