13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15Article - Transportation167-708.17(A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE
MEANINGS INDICATED.19(2) "9-1-1 SYSTEM" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 1-301 OF
THE PUBLIC SAFETY ARTICLE.

21 (3) "TEXT MESSAGING DEVICE" HAS THE MEANING STATED IN § 22 21–1124.1(A) OF THIS ARTICLE.

1 (B) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, A 2 PERSON MAY NOT USE A TEXT MESSAGING DEVICE TO WRITE, SEND, OR READ A 3 TEXT MESSAGE WHILE OPERATING A SUBWAY OR LIGHT RAIL VEHICLE.

4 (C) THIS SECTION DOES NOT APPLY TO THE USE OF A TEXT MESSAGING 5 DEVICE TO CONTACT A 9–1–1 SYSTEM.

6 (D) ANY PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS SECTION IS GUILTY OF A 7 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF NOT MORE THAN 8 **\$500.**

9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
10 October 1, 2010.
