17 18 19	(a) Except as provided under [subsection] <b>SUBSECTIONS</b> (b) <b>AND</b> (C) of this section, the record of a proceeding before the Board or a Board member is a public record.
20 21 22	(b) If the confidentiality of a record or report that the Board obtains is protected by law or regulation, the record or report shall remain confidential, subject to the law or regulation.

- 1 (C) THE BOARD MAY NOT ALLOW THE INSPECTION, USE, OR DISCLOSURE OF A CLAIMANT'S NAME, ADDRESS, TELEPHONE NUMBER, OR SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER, EXCEPT AS NECESSARY FOR THE BOARD TO ACCOMPLISH ITS FUNCTIONS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 October 1, 2010.
