12	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF					
13	MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(a) To qualify for a limited license, an applicant shall be an individual who					
17	meets the requirements of this section.					
18	(b) An applicant shall have trained as a pilot-in-training for at least 2 years.					
19	(c) An applicant shall possess sufficient ability, skill, and experience for a					
20	[28-foot-draft] 32-foot-draft] 36-foot-draft] 36-foot-draft]					
21	limited license, or a [37-foot-draft] 40-FOOT-DRAFT limited license as determined					
22	by the Board through observation of the applicant's performance providing pilotage.

- 4 (a) If an applicant qualifies for a license under this subtitle, the Board shall send the applicant a notice that states that:
- 6 (1) the applicant has qualified for a license; and
- 7 (2) the Board will issue the appropriate license to an applicant on 8 receipt of a license fee of:
- 9 (i) \$600 for an unlimited license;
- 10 \$300 for a [37-foot-draft] **40-FOOT-DRAFT** limited license;
- 11 \$300 for a [34-foot-draft] **36-FOOT-DRAFT** limited license;

- 19 (a) While an unlimited license is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to 20 provide pilotage for vessels of any draft.
- 21 (b) (1) While a [37-foot-draft] **40-FOOT-DRAFT** limited license is in 22 effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels not exceeding 23 [37-foot-draft] **40-FOOT-DRAFT**.
- 24 (2) While a [34–foot–draft] **36–FOOT–DRAFT** limited license is in effect, it authorizes the licensee to provide pilotage for vessels not exceeding [34–foot–draft] **36–FOOT–DRAFT**.
