# 2 Commissioner of Labor and Industry – Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act

3 FOR the purpose of altering the boiler and pressure vessel safety law relating to 4 applicants for a special inspector commission by repealing certain eligibility  $\mathbf{5}$ requirements; repealing a requirement that the Commissioner of Labor and 6 Industry establish certain insurance requirements by regulation; authorizing, 7 instead of requiring, the Board of Boiler Rules to give examinations to 8 applicants for special inspector commissions; repealing a certain provision 9 authorizing the Commissioner to issue a certain special inspector commission; providing that the Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector shall have 10 free access under certain circumstances to any premises in the State to 11 12investigate the activities of a special inspector; requiring the Chief Boiler 13Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector to make certain inspections, to respond to and investigate certain complaints, to inspect or investigate accidents or 14
