1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Commissioner of Labor and Industry – Boiler and Pressure Vessel Safety Act**

3 FOR the purpose of altering the boiler and pressure vessel safety law relating to
4 applicants for a special inspector commission by repealing certain eligibility
5 requirements; repealing a requirement that the Commissioner of Labor and
6 Industry establish certain insurance requirements by regulation; authorizing,
7 instead of requiring, the Board of Boiler Rules to give examinations to
8 applicants for special inspector commissions; repealing a certain provision
9 authorizing the Commissioner to issue a certain special inspector commission;
10 providing that the Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector shall have
11 free access under certain circumstances to any premises in the State to
12 investigate the activities of a special inspector; requiring the Chief Boiler
13 Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector to make certain inspections, to respond to
14 and investigate certain complaints, to inspect or investigate accidents or
15 explosions involving boilers and pressure vessels, and to monitor special
16 inspector inspections; authorizing the Chief Boiler Inspector, a deputy boiler
17 inspector, a special inspector, or an authorized inspection agency to make
18 certain inspections with respect to the installation, repair, or alteration of
19 boilers and pressure vessels; authorizing the Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy
20 boiler inspector to make certain inspections of antique or model steam boilers

13 or to submit to the Chief Boiler Inspector evidence of certain accreditation; and

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

22 **Article – Public Safety**

23 12–907.

24 (a) (1) The following entities may request the Commissioner to issue
25 special inspector commissions:

26 (i) an authorized insurer that insures boilers and pressure
27 vessels in the State; **OR**

28 (ii) [a person that operates pressure vessels in the State that
29 regularly are inspected and rated by an established inspection service under the
30 supervision of engineers whose qualifications are satisfactory to the Board and in
31 accordance with the regulations adopted under this subtitle; or

32 (iii)] an authorized inspection agency.

33 (2) On request of an entity described in paragraph (1) of this
34 subsection, the Commissioner may issue a special inspector commission to an
35 individual employed by the entity to serve as a special inspector if the entity and the
36 individual satisfy the requirements of this section.

1 (b) (1) An applicant for a special inspector commission shall be employed
2 by the entity that requests the special inspector commission.

3 (2) [An applicant for a special inspector commission for a person that
4 operates pressure vessels shall:

5 (i) be employed full time by the person; and

6 (ii) be responsible for making inspections of pressure vessels
7 that are used or to be used by the person and are not for resale.

8 (3)] An applicant for a special inspector commission shall:

9 (i) [pass the examination given by the Board under subsection
10 (e) of this section;

11 (ii) hold a commission or certificate of competency as an
12 inspector of boilers and pressure vessels in another state that has an examination
13 substantially equivalent to the examination given by the Board; or

14 (iii) 1.] hold a commission as an inspector of boilers and
15 pressure vessels issued by the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel
16 Inspectors; [and] **OR**

17 [2.] **(II)** pass [the part of] the examination given by the
18 Board [that differs from the national examination] **UNDER SUBSECTION ~~(E)~~ (D) OF**
19 **THIS SECTION.**

20 (c) (1) The employer of an applicant for a special inspector commission
21 shall:

22 (i) submit to the Commissioner an application on the form that
23 the Commissioner requires; and

24 (ii) pay to the Commissioner a fee of \$50.

25 (2) The application shall include:

26 (i) the name and qualifications of the individual who will serve
27 as a special inspector; and

28 (ii) evidence that the individual satisfies the requirements of
29 subsection (b) of this section.

~~(d) By regulation, the Commissioner shall establish insurance requirements that must be satisfied by an authorized inspection agency before a commission may be issued to an inspector employed by the authorized inspection agency.~~

~~(e)~~ **(D)** (1) The Board [shall] **MAY** give examinations to applicants for special inspector commissions as provided in this subsection.

(2) The examination:

(i) shall be in writing;

(ii) shall be limited to questions the answers to which will help to determine the fitness and competency of the individual for the intended service; and

(iii) may consist of questions prepared by the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors.

(3) (i) An applicant who fails the examination may appeal to the Board for a reexamination.

(ii) The reexamination shall be given by the Board within 90 days.

(4) The record of an applicant's examination shall be available to the applicant and the applicant's employer.

(5) The fee for an examination or reexamination is \$50.

~~(f)~~ ~~(4)~~ **(E)** The Commissioner shall issue a special inspector commission to each applicant who meets the requirements of this subtitle.

~~(2) The Commissioner may issue a special inspector commission to a representative of an employee organization covered by a collective bargaining agreement.~~

~~(g)~~ **(F)** An inspection by a special inspector of a boiler or pressure vessel insured or pressure vessel operated by the employer of the special inspector, or an inspection by a special inspector employed by an authorized inspection agency, exempts the owner or user of the boiler or pressure vessel from the payment to the State of inspection fees required by this subtitle for the boiler or pressure vessel.

~~(h)~~ **(G)** A special inspector may not receive a salary from or have any expenses paid by the State.

~~(i)~~ **(H)** (1) A special inspector commission expires 2 years after its effective date.

1 (2) Before a special inspector commission expires, the employer of the
2 special inspector may renew the commission if the employer:

3 (i) pays to the Commissioner a renewal fee of \$50; and

4 (ii) submits evidence to the Commissioner that the special
5 inspector:

6 1. meets the standards imposed by this subtitle;

7 2. remains in the employment of the employer; and

8 3. has been trained on current boiler and pressure vessel
9 technology in accordance with regulations adopted under this subtitle.

10 ~~(I)~~ **(I)** Within 30 days after the termination of the employment of a special
11 inspector, the employer shall return the special inspector commission to the Chief
12 Boiler Inspector.

13 ~~(J)~~ **(J)** (1) If an identification card of a special inspector is lost or
14 destroyed, the Commissioner shall issue a new identification card in its place without
15 another examination.

16 (2) The fee for replacement of an identification card is \$50.

17 ~~(K)~~ **(K)** (1) After investigation and recommendation by the Board, the
18 Commissioner may suspend the special inspector commission for:

19 (i) incompetence of the special inspector;

20 (ii) untrustworthiness of the special inspector;

21 (iii) willful falsification of any matter or statement contained in
22 the application for the special inspector commission; or

23 (iv) willful falsification of any matter or statement contained in
24 a report of an inspection made by the special inspector.

25 (2) Within 10 days after suspending a special inspector commission,
26 the Commissioner shall give written notice of the suspension to the special inspector
27 and the employer of the special inspector.

28 (3) (i) An individual whose special inspector commission has been
29 suspended may appeal to the Board.

30 (ii) At the hearing on the appeal, the individual may be present
31 and represented by counsel.

1 (4) An individual whose special inspector commission has been
2 suspended may apply for reinstatement of the commission after 90 days following the
3 date of the suspension.

4 ~~(m)~~ (L) (1) If the Board has reason to believe that a special inspector is no
5 longer qualified to hold a commission, the Board shall hold a hearing.

6 (2) The Board shall give at least 10 days' written notice of the hearing
7 to the special inspector and to the employer of the special inspector.

8 (3) At the hearing, the special inspector and the employer shall have
9 an opportunity to be heard.

10 (4) If after the hearing the Board finds that the special inspector is no
11 longer qualified to hold a commission:

12 (i) the Board shall recommend to the Commissioner that the
13 special inspector commission be revoked; and

14 (ii) the Commissioner shall revoke the special inspector
15 commission immediately.

17 (a) The requirements of this section and §§ 12-910 and 12-911 of this
18 subtitle do not apply to:

19 (1) a boiler or pressure vessel that is located on a farm and used solely
20 for agricultural purposes;

21 (2) a heating boiler that is located in a private residence or an
22 apartment house with less than six family units;

23 (3) a pressure vessel that:

24 (i) contains only water under pressure for domestic supply
25 purposes, including a pressure vessel that contains air, the compression of which
26 serves only as a cushion or airlift pumping system; and

27 (ii) is located in a private residence or an apartment house with
28 less than six family units; or

29 (4) an exhibition or antique boiler or pressure vessel, including a
30 steam or gas engine, wheat thresher, or antique tractor, if the boiler or pressure
31 vessel:

1 (i) has been inspected and issued a certificate of [safety]
2 INSPECTION by another state that has safety requirements equal to or greater than
3 those of this State; and

4 (ii) has been brought into this State to be used in a temporary
5 exhibit or show.

6 (b) The Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector shall have free
7 access, during reasonable hours, to any premises in the State:

8 (1) to determine whether a boiler or pressure vessel is being
9 constructed for use or installed in the State in accordance with this subtitle;

10 (2) to inspect or investigate an accident or explosion that involves a
11 boiler or pressure vessel; [or]

12 (3) to make an inspection required under this subtitle; **OR**

13 **(4) TO INVESTIGATE AN INSPECTION OF A SPECIAL INSPECTOR.**

14 (c) (1) [Except as provided in paragraphs (2), (3), (4), and (5) of this
15 subsection, the Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector shall make the
16 certificate inspections required under subsection (d) of this section.] **IN ADDITION TO**
17 **THE CERTIFICATE INSPECTIONS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS**
18 **SECTION, THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR OR A DEPUTY BOILER INSPECTOR**
19 **SHALL:**

20 **(I) INSPECT OR INVESTIGATE ACCIDENTS AND EXPLOSIONS**
21 **INVOLVING BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS;**

22 **(II) RESPOND TO AND INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS ABOUT**
23 **THE OPERATION OF BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS; AND**

24 **(III) MONITOR THE INSPECTIONS OF SPECIAL INSPECTORS.**

25 **(2) THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR, A DEPUTY BOILER**
26 **INSPECTOR, A SPECIAL INSPECTOR, OR AN AUTHORIZED INSPECTION AGENCY**
27 **MAY:**

28 **(I) MAKE CERTIFICATE INSPECTIONS OF THE**
29 **INSTALLATION OF NEW BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS; AND**

30 **(II) MAKE CERTIFICATE INSPECTIONS OF THE REPAIR OR**
31 **ALTERATION OF BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS.**

1 **(3) THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR OR A DEPUTY BOILER**
2 **INSPECTOR MAY MAKE A CERTIFICATE INSPECTION OF AN ANTIQUE BOILER OR**
3 **PRESSURE VESSEL OR A MODEL STEAM BOILER.**

4 **[(2)] (4) [If] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPHS (1)**
5 **THROUGH (3) OF THIS SUBSECTION, IF** a boiler or pressure vessel:

6 **(I)** is insured by an insurer, a special inspector employed by the
7 insurer[,] or **EMPLOYED** by an authorized inspection agency under contract with the
8 insurer[,] shall make the inspections required under subsection (d) of this section; **OR**

9 **(II) IS NOT INSURED BY AN INSURER, THE OWNER SHALL**
10 **CONTRACT WITH THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR, A DEPUTY BOILER**
11 **INSPECTOR, A SPECIAL INSPECTOR, OR AN AUTHORIZED INSPECTION AGENCY**
12 **TO MAKE THE INSPECTIONS REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS**
13 **SECTION.**

14 **[(3)]** If a pressure vessel is owned or operated by a person who employs
15 a special inspector who holds a commission, the special inspector, or a special
16 inspector employed by an authorized inspection agency under contract with the owner
17 or operator, shall make the inspections required under subsection (d) of this section.]

18 **[(4)] (5) (i)** In this paragraph, “private inspector” means an
19 individual who:

20 1. has a level II or level III certification from the
21 American Society for Nondestructive Testing (ASNT); and

22 2. is commissioned as a special inspector by the National
23 Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel Inspectors.

24 (ii) If a boiler or pressure vessel is an exhibition or antique
25 boiler or pressure vessel, including a steam or gas engine, wheat thresher, **MODEL**
26 **STEAM BOILER**, or antique tractor, that will be used in an exhibit or show for
27 noncommercial purposes, the inspections required under subsection (d) of this section
28 may be made by a private inspector.

29 (iii) If a private inspector makes the inspections required under
30 subsection (d) of this section, the private inspector shall file a report with the Chief
31 Boiler Inspector on the results of the inspection.

32 (iv) If the report of the private inspector shows that the
33 exhibition or antique boiler or pressure vessel complies with the requirements of
34 subsection (d) of this section and the regulations adopted under this subtitle, the Chief
35 Boiler Inspector shall issue a certificate to the owner or user of the exhibition or

1 antique boiler or pressure vessel that authorizes it to be used in an exhibit or show for
2 noncommercial purposes.

3 ~~[(5)]~~ **(6)** If a boiler or pressure vessel is not insured by an insurer,
4 the Commissioner may contract with an insurer or an authorized inspection agency to
5 have a special inspector who is employed by that insurer or authorized inspection
6 agency make the inspections required under **PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SUBSECTION**
7 **AND** subsection (d) of this section **OR CONDUCTED UNDER PARAGRAPH (2) OR (3)**
8 **OF THIS SUBSECTION.**

9 (d) (1) Except for boilers and pressure vessels exempt under subsection
10 (a) of this section or § 12-903 of this subtitle, each boiler and each pressure vessel that
11 is used or proposed to be used in the State shall be inspected [thoroughly as to its
12 construction, installation, and condition in accordance with this subsection], **TESTED,**
13 **AND MAINTAINED IN A SAFE OPERATING CONDITION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE**
14 **REGULATIONS ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE**
15 **BOARD.**

16 (2) A certificate inspection required under this subsection shall be:

17 (i) an internal inspection if construction allows; or

18 (ii) an inspection that is as complete as possible.

19 (3) (i) Except for model steam boilers, a power boiler or a high
20 pressure, high temperature water boiler shall:

21 1. receive a certificate inspection annually; and

22 2. be externally inspected annually while under
23 pressure, if possible.

24 (ii) The Board may extend to 2 years the interval between
25 certificate inspections of a power boiler if:

26 1. the power boiler has internal continuous water
27 treatment under the general supervision of a professional engineer who has experience
28 in the treatment of boiler water; and

29 2. the owner or user of the power boiler keeps available,
30 for examination by the Chief Boiler Inspector or by a deputy boiler inspector or special
31 inspector, accurate records that show:

32 A. the date, time, and reason that the power boiler is out
33 of service; and

1 B. a chemical and physical analysis of samples of the
2 boiler water taken at regular intervals of not more than 48 hours of operation that
3 adequately show the condition of the boiler water and any elements or characteristics
4 of the boiler water that are capable of producing corrosion or other deterioration of the
5 power boiler or its parts.

6 (4) A nuclear vessel within the scope of this subtitle shall be inspected
7 and reported in a form and with appropriate information designated by the Board.

8 (5) (i) Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection,
9 certificate inspections shall be conducted at time intervals set forth in regulations
10 adopted under this subtitle and in accordance with Title 10 of the State Government
11 Article.

12 (ii) The intervals shall protect public safety taking into
13 consideration, consistent with § 12–905 of this subtitle, the design, type, age, extent of
14 automated monitoring, fuel, and operating characteristics of the boiler or pressure
15 vessel.

16 (e) If, at the discretion of the inspector, a hydrostatic test is considered
17 necessary, the owner or user of a boiler or pressure vessel shall make the hydrostatic
18 test.

19 (f) (1) Except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, at least 30
20 days before installing a boiler or pressure vessel covered by this subtitle, the person
21 who will perform the installation shall give the Commissioner notice of the installation
22 in accordance with regulations adopted under this subtitle.

23 (2) Under emergency circumstances, the person who will perform the
24 installation of a boiler or pressure vessel may give the Commissioner notice of the
25 installation less than 30 days before installation in accordance with regulations
26 adopted under this subtitle.

27 (3) Except for a cast–iron sectional boiler or pressure vessel, each
28 boiler to be installed in the State shall be inspected:

29 (i) during construction or field assembly, as required by
30 regulations adopted under this subtitle, by [an inspector authorized to inspect boilers
31 and pressure vessels in the State] **THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR, A DEPUTY**
32 **BOILER INSPECTOR, A SPECIAL INSPECTOR, OR AN AUTHORIZED INSPECTION**
33 **AGENCY;** or

34 (ii) if the boiler is constructed outside the State, by an inspector
35 who holds a commission issued by the National Board of Boiler and Pressure Vessel
36 Inspectors.

1 (g) (1) Within 24 hours after an accident or explosion, the owner or user of
2 a boiler or pressure vessel shall give the Chief Boiler Inspector notice of the accident
3 or explosion in accordance with regulations adopted under this subtitle.

4 (2) On notification or information, the Chief Boiler Inspector or a
5 deputy boiler inspector shall investigate each accident or explosion that involves a
6 boiler or pressure vessel covered by this subtitle.

7 (h) (1) The Board shall provide for public safety and therefore has
8 jurisdiction over the interpretation and application of the inspection requirements
9 provided in the regulations adopted under this subtitle.

10 (2) Inspection requirements of operating equipment shall:

11 (i) be in accordance with generally accepted practice; and

12 (ii) be compatible with the actual service conditions, including:

- 13 1. previous experience, based on records of performance
- 14 and maintenance;
- 15 2. location, with respect to personnel hazard;
- 16 3. provision for related safe operation of controls; and
- 17 4. interrelation with other operations outside the scope
- 18 of this subtitle.

19 (i) The owner or user of a boiler or pressure vessel required by this subtitle
20 to be inspected by the Chief Boiler Inspector or a deputy boiler inspector shall pay
21 directly to the Chief Boiler Inspector, on completion of the inspection, a fee in
22 accordance with the following schedule:

23 (1) certificate inspection:

24 (i) initial certificate inspection of a boiler or pressure vessel not
25 previously inspected in the State ~~[no charge]~~ ~~\$40~~

26 [(ii) certificate inspection of a boiler or pressure vessel, other
27 than a pressure vessel attached to an air compressor, previously inspected in the
28 State.....\$40

29 (iii) certificate inspection of a pressure vessel, attached to an air

31 (iv) certificate inspection of an additional boiler or pressure

6 (4) [special inspection] OTHER INSPECTIONS, such as an inspection
7 at a fabrication or repair facility, ASME joint review, or National Board of Inspection
8 Code Repair Review, shall be charged at the following rates, and shall include all
9 expenses such as travel and hotel costs:

10 (i) half day (up to 4 hours) \$250

11 (ii) full day (up to 8 hours) \$500

13 (a) (1) Each [authorized insurer, or] authorized inspection agency[,] that
14 employs a special inspector shall file with the Chief Boiler Inspector a report on:

15 (i) each certificate inspection; and

16 (ii) any other inspection for which a report is required to be filed
17 under regulations adopted under this subtitle.

18 (2) The report filed under paragraph (1) of this subsection shall:

19 (i) be filed within 30 days after an inspection; and

20 (ii) be in the form required by regulations adopted under this
21 subtitle.

22 (3) For each report not filed electronically, the authorized [insurer]
23 INSPECTION AGENCY shall pay a \$5 report filing fee.

24 (4) Within 24 hours after an inspection, each [authorized insurer, or]
25 authorized inspection agency[,] that employs a special inspector shall notify the Chief
26 Boiler Inspector if an inspection reveals a hazardous condition as described in §
27 12-915(a)(2) of this subtitle that affects the safety of a boiler or pressure vessel.

1 (a) If the report filed in accordance with § 12–910(a) of this subtitle shows
2 that a boiler or pressure vessel complies with regulations adopted under this subtitle,
3 the Chief Boiler Inspector, **ON RECEIPT FROM THE OWNER OR USER OF A BOILER**
4 **OR PRESSURE VESSEL OF PAYMENT FOR A CERTIFICATE FEE IN THE AMOUNT**
5 **REQUIRED BY SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION**, shall issue to the owner or user
6 of the boiler or pressure vessel a certificate that bears the date of inspection, specifies
7 the inspection interval, and specifies the maximum pressure under which the boiler or
8 pressure vessel may be operated.

9 (b) **AN OWNER OR USER OF A BOILER OR PRESSURE VESSEL SHALL PAY**
10 **A FEE OF \$40 FOR THE CERTIFICATE.**

11 [(b)] (c) Except as provided in § 12–909(d)(3) of this subtitle, the certificate
12 is valid for the period that corresponds to the interval between certificate inspections
13 as established by regulation under § 12–909 of this subtitle.

14 [(c)] (d) If the certificate inspection interval for a boiler or pressure vessel
15 is extended under § 12–909(d)(5) of this subtitle, the Chief Boiler Inspector shall
16 promptly issue a certificate to the owner of the boiler or pressure vessel that bears the
17 new expiration date.

18 [(d)] (e) (1) The certificate shall be posted under glass in the room that
19 contains the boiler or pressure vessel that was inspected.

20 (2) If the boiler or pressure vessel is not located in a building, the
21 certificate shall be posted in a location convenient to the boiler or pressure vessel that
22 was inspected or in any place where the certificate will be accessible to interested
23 parties.

24 [(e)] (f) (1) The Chief Boiler Inspector or an authorized deputy boiler
25 inspector may suspend a certificate at any time when, in the opinion of the inspector,
26 the boiler or pressure vessel for which the certificate was issued:

27 (i) cannot be operated without danger to public safety; or
28 (ii) is found not to comply with regulations adopted under this
29 subtitle.

30 (2) The suspension of a certificate continues until:

31 (i) the boiler or pressure vessel is made to conform to the
32 regulations adopted under this subtitle; and

33 (ii) the certificate is reinstated.

1 **[(f)] (G)** If a boiler or pressure vessel for which a certificate was issued
 2 based on the report of a special inspector ceases to be insured by an authorized
 3 insurer, the certificate is invalid.

5 (a) An authorized insurer that provides insurance coverage for boilers or
 6 pressure vessels in the State shall:

7 (1) conduct the certificate inspection for each boiler and pressure
 8 vessel that the insurer insures by the date the certificate inspection is due;

9 (2) file with the Chief Boiler Inspector the reports required under §
 10 12-910 of this subtitle;

11 (3) develop, maintain, submit, and update, as defined by regulation, a
 12 database of all boilers and pressure vessels that the insurer insures in the State and
 13 track the date when the certificate inspection for each boiler or pressure vessel is due
 14 to ensure that the certificate inspections are due and completed as required under this
 15 subtitle; and

16 (4) **(I)** develop, maintain, and make available to the Commissioner
 17 **FOR INSPECTION AT THE INSURER'S PLACE OF BUSINESS IN THE STATE** a quality
 18 assurance program in accordance with regulations adopted under this subtitle; **OR**

19 **(II) SUBMIT TO THE CHIEF BOILER INSPECTOR EVIDENCE**
 20 **OF NB-369 ACCREDITATION BY THE NATIONAL BOARD OF BOILER AND**
 21 **PRESSURE VESSEL INSPECTORS.**

22 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 23 October 1, 2010.
