18	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

22	(a) (1) Each county board or county health department shall provide
23	hearing and vision screenings for all students in the public schools.

- 1 (2) Each county health department shall provide and fund hearing 2 and vision screenings for all students:
- 3 (i) In any private school that has received a certificate of 4 approval under $\S 2-206$ of this article; and
- 5 (ii) In any nonpublic educational facility in this State approved as a special education facility by the Department.
- 7 (b) (1) Unless evidence is presented that a student has been tested within 8 the past year, the screenings required under subsection (a) of this section shall be 9 given in the year that a student enters a school system, enters the first grade, and 10 enters the eighth or ninth grade.

- 12 (A) BEFORE ENTERING A PUBLIC SCHOOL SYSTEM, THE PARENT OR
 13 LEGAL GUARDIAN OF A PUBLIC SCHOOL STUDENT SHALL ENSURE THAT THE
 14 STUDENT HAS BEEN SCREENED FOR HEARING AND VISION PROBLEMS.
- 15 (B) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP A PROCEDURE TO 16 DETERMINE COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
