2 **Dorchester County – Membership of Sanitary Commission**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the number of sanitary commissioners in the
4 Dorchester County Sanitary Commission; and generally relating to the sanitary
5 commission for Dorchester County.

11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
12 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

13 **Article – Environment**

14 9–622.

15 (a) (1) The sanitary commission of each single county district consists of
16 the following numbers of sanitary commissioners, each appointed by the governing
17 body of the member county:

18 (i) Allegany County – 7;

19 (ii) Dorchester County – **[5] 6**;

20 (iii) Somerset County, except as provided in paragraph (2) of this
21 subsection – 5;

3 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
