- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

### **Article – Education**

21 4-306.2.

(a) The board may issue bonds for the purpose of financing or refinancing all
or any part of the costs of any project.

1 (b) (1) [The] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS 2 SUBSECTION, THE aggregate principal amount of bonds outstanding, including the 3 amount of any reserve fund requirement established for the bonds, may not exceed, as 4 of the date that the bonds are issued, \$100,000,000.

5 (2) THE AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF BONDS 6 OUTSTANDING DOES NOT INCLUDE QUALIFIED SCHOOL CONSTRUCTION BONDS 7 AS DEFINED IN § 54F OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 9 June 1, 2010.
