AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 2011, the State Board for Professional Land Surveyors shall submit a report to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Environmental Matters Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on its plans to implement board member training.
