- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, on or before October 1, 2011, the State Board of Examiners in Optometry shall submit a report to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Health and Government Operations Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on the actions the Board has taken to:
- 25 (1) Monitor the decline in new licenses issued and include any 26 recommendations the Board has made to address the decline;
- 27 (2) Track developments in the scope of practice for optometry and 28 their potential impact on entry into the profession in order to ensure that access to eye 29 care in Maryland does not become a problem;
- 30 (3) Review future revenue and expenditure trends to determine if a fee 31 increase may be necessary; and
- 32 (4) Implement a biennial renewal cycle to maintain a more consistent 33 fund balance.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 2 $\,$ July 1, 2010.
