SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article – Business Occupations and Professions

4 9–702.

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Subject to the evaluation and reestablishment provisions of the Maryland Program Evaluation Act, this title and all regulations adopted under this title shall terminate and be of no effect after July 1, [2013] **2024**.

## Article - State Government

- 9 8-403.
- 10 (a) On or before December 15 of the 2nd year before the evaluation date of a governmental activity or unit, the Legislative Policy Committee, based on a preliminary evaluation, may waive as unnecessary the evaluation required under this section.
- 14 (b) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (a) of this section, on or before 15 the evaluation date for the following governmental activities or units, an evaluation 16 shall be made of the following governmental activities or units and the statutes and 17 regulations that relate to the governmental activities or units:
- 18 (36) Landscape Architects, State Board of Examiners of (§ 9–201 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article: July 1, [2012] **2023**);
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That on or before October 1, 2011, the State Board of Examiners of Landscape Architects, in conjunction with the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation, shall submit a report to the Senate Education, Health, and Environmental Affairs Committee and the House Economic Matters Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article, on its consideration of:
- 26 (1) instituting a continuing education requirement for landscape 27 architects; and
- 28 (2) allowing individuals who have a college degree in a field related to 29 landscape architecture to sit for the licensing examination under the academic option 30 as described in § 9–303 of the Business Occupations and Professions Article.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
