## A BILL ENTITLED

### 1 AN ACT concerning

## Seasonal Farmer's Market Producer Sampling License

FOR the purpose of authorizing a county to establish a seasonal farmer's market producer sampling license to allow a producer of a farm product to prepare and offer samples of the product at a farmer's market; requiring the license to be valid at all farmer's markets in the county for a certain time period, for a single fee; limiting a licensee to offer samples only of a product produced by the licensee; requiring a county issuing the license to adopt certain ordinances; and generally relating to product sampling at farmer's markets.

15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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## Article – Health – General

19 (A) A COUNTY MAY ESTABLISH A SEASONAL FARMER'S MARKET
20 PRODUCER SAMPLING LICENSE TO BE REQUIRED FOR A PRODUCER OF A FARM
21 PRODUCT TO PREPARE AND OFFER SAMPLES OF THE FARM PRODUCT FOR
22 HUMAN CONSUMPTION AT A FARMER'S MARKET.

2 HOUSE BILL 167 (1) **BE VALID AT ALL FARMER'S MARKETS IN THE COUNTY;** 1  $\mathbf{2}$ (2) BE VALID FOR THE ENTIRE SEASON FOR WHICH IT IS ISSUED; 3 AND 4 (3) HAVE A SINGLE FEE AS SET BY THE COUNTY.  $\mathbf{5}$ **(C)** A SEASONAL FARMER'S MARKET PRODUCER SAMPLING LICENSEE SHALL USE THE LICENSE ONLY TO OFFER SAMPLES OF A FARM PRODUCT THAT 6 7 HAS BEEN PRODUCED BY THE LICENSEE. 8 **(**D**)** A COUNTY ISSUING A FARMER'S MARKET PRODUCER SAMPLING LICENSE SHALL ADOPT AN ORDINANCE THAT: 9 10 (1) **ESTABLISHES ELIGIBILITY FOR THE LICENSE;** 11 (2) **PROVIDES FOR THE AUTHORIZED USES OF THE LICENSE;** 12(3) ESTABLISHES STANDARDS AND APPROVED METHODS UNDER 13WHICH SAMPLING SHALL BE CONDUCTED; 14(4) SPECIFIES THE DURATION OF THE SEASON DURING WHICH 15THE LICENSE IS VALID; 16(5) **SETS THE FEE FOR THE LICENSE;** (6) 17**PROVIDES FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF PROVISIONS OF LAW** UNDER WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED: 18 19(7) **PROVIDES PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF PROVISIONS OF** 20LAW UNDER WHICH THE LICENSE IS ISSUED; AND 21(8) INCLUDES OTHER PROVISIONS THAT THE COUNTY 22DETERMINES ARE NECESSARY TO PROTECT PUBLIC HEALTH AND CONTROL 23FOODBORNE ILLNESSES. 24SECTION 2.
