1 AN ACT concerning 2 Criminal Law - Abuse or Neglect of Animal - Increased Penalties 3 FOR the purpose of increasing the penalties for certain violations concerning the 4 abuse or neglect of animals; authorizing a court, as a condition of sentencing, to 5 prohibit a certain defendant from the future ownership of an animal; and 6 generally relating to animal cruelty. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, 8 Article - Criminal Law 9 Section 10-604 and 10-606 10 Annotated Code of Maryland (2002 Volume and 2009 Supplement) 11 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 12 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 14 Article - Criminal Law 10-604. 15 16 (a) A person may not: 17 overdrive or overload an animal; (1) 18 (2) deprive an animal of necessary sustenance; 19 inflict unnecessary suffering or pain on an animal; (3)

1 cause, procure, or authorize an act prohibited under item (1), (2), or **(4)** 2 (3) of this subsection; or 3 if the person has charge or custody of an animal, as owner or 4 otherwise, unnecessarily fail to provide the animal with nutritious food in sufficient 5 quantity, necessary veterinary care, proper drink, air, space, shelter, or protection from the weather. 6 7 (b) A person who violates this section is guilty of a misdemeanor and 8 on conviction is subject to imprisonment not exceeding [90 days] 1 YEAR or a fine not exceeding [\$1.000] **\$2.500** or both. 9 10 **(2)** As a condition of sentencing, the court may: 11 order a defendant convicted of violating this section to **(I)** 12 participate in and pay for psychological counseling; AND PROHIBIT A DEFENDANT CONVICTED OF VIOLATING 13 14 THIS SECTION FROM FUTURE OWNERSHIP OF AN ANIMAL. 15 10-606. 16 (a) A person may not: 17 (1) intentionally mutilate, torture, cruelly beat, or cruelly kill an 18 animal; 19 (2) cause, procure, or authorize an act prohibited under item (1) of this 20 subsection; or 21except in the case of self-defense, intentionally inflict bodily harm, 22 permanent disability, or death on an animal owned or used by a law enforcement unit. 23 (b) (1) A person who violates this section is guilty of the felony of aggravated cruelty to animals and on conviction is subject to imprisonment not 2425exceeding 3 years or a fine not exceeding \$5,000 or both. 26 As a condition of sentencing, the court may: **(2)** 27 **(I)** order a defendant convicted of violating this section to 28participate in and pay for psychological counseling; AND 29 (II)PROHIBIT A DEFENDANT CONVICTED OF VIOLATING

THIS SECTION FROM FUTURE OWNERSHIP OF AN ANIMAL.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
