2 Maryland Locksmiths Act – Revisions – Definitions and Records Inspection

3 FOR the purpose of altering the definition of "fixed business address" as it relates to 4 the Maryland Locksmiths Act to include a business location outside Maryland $\mathbf{5}$ where a licensed locksmith conducts a business and is available at certain 6 times; altering the definition of "local law enforcement unit" as it relates to the 7Maryland Locksmiths Act to include only in-State police departments and 8 sheriffs that are designated by certain entities based on the address of a 9 licensed locksmith for certain purposes; requiring licensed locksmiths to make 10 certain records available for inspection by the Department of Labor, Licensing, and Regulation under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the 11 12revision of definitions and records requirements of the Maryland Locksmiths 13 Act.
