## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

### 2 Office of Student Financial Assistance – Service Obligation – Waiver

- FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance in the
  Maryland Higher Education Commission to grant a waiver from the remaining
  service obligation component of certain scholarships under certain
  circumstances; requiring the Office to adopt certain regulations; and generally
  relating to the waiver of a service obligation commitment by the Office of
  Student Financial Assistance.

- 14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 16 Article Education
- 17 **18–206.**

18 **(A)** THE OFFICE SHALL GRANT A WAIVER FROM THE REMAINING 19 SERVICE OBLIGATION COMPONENT OF A SCHOLARSHIP AWARDED UNDER THIS 20 TITLE TO AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:

(1) HAS COMPLETED OR WILL COMPLETE 50% OF THE
 INDIVIDUAL'S SERVICE OBLIGATION COMPONENT ON OR BEFORE THE DATE THE
 INDIVIDUAL TERMINATES THE SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT;

1 (2) COMPLIED WITH ALL THE TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP 2 AWARD WHILE PERFORMING THE SERVICE OBLIGATION COMPONENT;

3 (3) HAS NOT RECEIVED THE AWARD MONEY THE INDIVIDUAL
4 WOULD HAVE RECEIVED IF THE INDIVIDUAL HAD PERFORMED THE SERVICES OF
5 THE REMAINING 50% OF THE SERVICE OBLIGATION;

- (4) SUBMITS TO THE OFFICE:

7 (I) WRITTEN NOTICE OF THE INDIVIDUAL'S INTENTION TO
8 TERMINATE THE SCHOLARSHIP CONTRACT BEFORE THE DATE SET FORTH IN
9 THE CONTRACT; AND

10(II) DOCUMENTATION OF A BONA FIDE OFFER OF11EMPLOYMENT FROM A FEDERAL, STATE, OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT ENTITY,12NONPROFIT HEALTH ORGANIZATION, OR FEDERALLY QUALIFIED HEALTH13CENTER; AND

14 (5) PAYS TO THE OFFICE AN EARLY CONTRACT TERMINATION 15 FINANCIAL PENALTY THAT IS EQUAL TO 5% OF THE VALUE OF THE AMOUNT OF 16 OBLIGATED SERVICE TIME NOT SERVED WITHIN A REASONABLE PERIOD OF 17 TIME, AS DETERMINED BY THE OFFICE.

18 **(B)** THE OFFICE SHALL ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE 19 PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 July 1, 2010.
