# 2 Office of Student Financial Assistance – Service Obligation – Waiver 3 Financial Counseling Session Required

FOR the purpose of requiring the Office of Student Financial Assistance in the 4  $\mathbf{5}$ Maryland Higher Education Commission to grant a waiver from the remaining 6 service obligation component of certain scholarships under certain 7circumstances require certain individuals to attend a certain financial 8 counseling session under certain circumstances; specifying that the financial 9 counseling session include certain matters; requiring the Office to adopt certain 10 regulations; providing for the application of this Act; and generally relating to the waiver of a service obligation commitment by a financial counseling session 11 12for applicants for certain student financial assistance by the Office of Student Financial Assistance. 13
