1 AN ACT concerning

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Natural Resources - Oyster Harvest - Closure of State Water

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Department of Natural Resources to keep certain 4 waters of the State open for oyster harvesting unless the Department makes 5 certain determinations or except as required by law; requiring the Department 6 to manage certain waters of the State to support, promote, and enhance oyster 7 harvesting opportunities to a certain extent; requiring the Department to 8 manage certain waters of the State to prevent any net loss of waters available 9 for oyster harvesting or of available oyster harvest authorizations; requiring the 10 Department to submit to the General Assembly a certain annual report; and 11 generally relating to closures of certain waters of the State to oyster harvesting.

8 9	(c) (1) Conservation and management measures adopted under a fishery management plan, to the extent possible:
10 11	(i) Shall prevent overfishing while attempting to achieve the best and most efficient utilization of the State's fishery resources;
12	(ii) Shall be based on the best information available;
13 14	(iii) May not discriminate unfairly among groups of fishermen or have economic allocation as its sole purpose;
15 16	(iv) Shall take into account and allow for variations among, and contingencies in, fisheries, fishery resources, and catches; and
17 18	(v) Shall avoid duplication of regulatory efforts and unnecessary costs to the State and to any other person.
