- (b) At least 1 month before the license expires, the Board shall send to the licensee, by first—class mail to the last known address of the licensee, OR BY ELECTRONIC MAIL TO THE LAST KNOWN ELECTRONIC MAIL ADDRESS OF THE LICENSEE, a renewal notice that states:
- 9 (1) The date on which the current license expires;
- 10 (2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
- 12 (3) The amount of the renewal fee.
- 13 (c) Before the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional 2—year term, if the licensee:
