1 (1) PROVIDE NOTICE OF THE DESIGN OR MODIFICATION TO 2 COMMUNITIES LOCATED WITHIN 3 MILES OF THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION 3 SITE; AND

4 (2) CONSULT WITH COMMUNITIES LOCATED WITHIN 3 MILES OF 5 THE PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION SITE THROUGH MEETINGS WITH LOCAL CIVIC 6 ASSOCIATIONS, GOVERNMENT AGENCIES, AND OTHER INTERESTED PARTIES 7 REGARDING THE PROJECT DESIGN AND METHODS TO MINIMIZE ADVERSE 8 EFFECTS ON THESE COMMUNITIES INCLUDING:

9 (I) NOISE;

10 **(II) TRAFFIC;**

- 11 (III) POLLUTION;
- 12 (IV) LOSS OF OPEN SPACE; AND
- 13 (V) OTHER DETRIMENTS.
