16 (a) At least once every [2] 3 years, the OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR
 17 GENERAL IN THE Department shall:

18 (1) conduct or contract for a financial and compliance audit of each19 local department; and

20 (2) prepare a written report of the audit findings.

21 (b) The audit shall comply with the auditing standards issued by the 22 Institute of Internal Auditors.

1 (c) The written report of the audit findings shall be distributed to:

- 2 (1) the local board; and
