12 13	SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16	(a) (1) Each employer:
17	(i) shall set regular pay periods; and
18 19 20 21	(ii) except as provided in paragraph (2) of this subsection, shall pay each employee at least once in every 2 weeks or twice in each month THE REGULAR FULL WAGE EARNED FOR EACH PAY PERIOD ON ALL PAYDAYS THAT FALL WITHIN ANY GIVEN YEAR.
22 23	(2) An employer may pay an administrative, executive, or professional employee less frequently than required under paragraph (1)(ii) of this subsection.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2010.
