3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from using a wireless communication device to engage in certain activities while operating a subway vehicle, light rail 4 5 vehicle, or motor vehicle that is in motion; authorizing a person to use a 6 wireless communication device to engage in certain activities while operating a 7 subway vehicle, light rail vehicle, or a motor vehicle that is in motion; repealing 8 certain provisions of law relating to text messaging devices; defining certain 9 terms; and generally relating to the use of a wireless communication device while operating a subway vehicle, light rail vehicle, or motor vehicle. 10
