1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Washington County – Alcoholic Beverages – Beer Tasting License**

3 FOR the purpose of establishing a beer tasting license in Washington County;
4 authorizing the issuance of the license only to certain persons; specifying that
5 the license allows the consumption of beer for tasting purposes only; requiring
6 the Board of License Commissioners to regulate certain conditions under which
7 a tasting may be held; specifying a license fee; authorizing the Board to adopt
8 certain regulations; making a certain technical change; and generally relating
9 to alcoholic beverages in Washington County.

20 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
21 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN WASHINGTON COUNTY.

4 (B) IN THIS SECTION, “BOARD” MEANS THE BOARD OF LICENSE
5 COMMISSIONERS.6 (C) THE BOARD MAY ISSUE A BEER TASTING (BT) ALCOHOLIC
7 BEVERAGES LICENSE.8 (D) THE LICENSE MAY BE ISSUED ONLY TO A HOLDER OF A CLASS A OR
9 CLASS B BEER AND WINE (BW) LICENSE OR A CLASS A OR CLASS B BEER, WINE
10 AND LIQUOR (BWL) LICENSE IN THE COUNTY.11 (E) (1) THE BT LICENSE PERMITS THE CONSUMPTION OF BEER FOR
12 TASTING PURPOSES ONLY.13 (2) TO HOLD A BEER TASTING, A HOLDER OF THE BT LICENSE
14 SHALL PROVIDE BEER TO CONSUMERS AT NO CHARGE.

15 (F) THE BOARD SHALL REGULATE:

16 (1) THE QUANTITY OF BEER TO BE SERVED TO EACH PERSON;

17 (2) THE NUMBER OF BOTTLES OR OTHER CONTAINERS OF BEER
18 FROM WHICH THIS QUANTITY IS BEING SERVED; AND

19 (3) THE SIZE OF THE BOTTLES OR OTHER CONTAINERS.

20 (G) (1) THE ANNUAL BT LICENSE FEE IS \$100.

21 (2) THE FEE IS IN ADDITION TO THE BW LICENSE FEE OR THE
22 BWL LICENSE FEE.23 (H) THE BOARD MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS
24 SECTION.

25 9-102.

26 (a) No more than one license provided by this article, except by way of
27 renewal or as otherwise provided in this section, shall be issued in any county or
28 Baltimore City, to any person, or for the use of any partnership, corporation,

1 unincorporated association, or limited liability company, in Baltimore City or any
2 county of the State, and no more than one license shall be issued for the same
3 premises except as provided in §§ 2-201 through 2-208, 2-301, and 6-701 of this
4 article, and nothing herein shall be construed to apply to § 6-201(r)(4), (15), and (17), §
5 7-101(b) and (c), § 8-202(g)(2)(ii) and (iii), § 8-217(e), § 8-508, **§ 8-902**, or § 12-202 of
6 this article.

7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
8 July 1, 2010.
