A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 Secretary of Agriculture - Mosquito Control - Enforcement Authority

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to issue and serve a mosquito abatement order on certain persons under certain circumstances; authorizing the Secretary to enter on and inspect private property for certain purposes; authorizing the Secretary to bring action for injunctive relief under certain circumstances; establishing a certain penalty for any person who violates a mosquito abatement order issued by the Secretary; and generally relating to mosquito abatement by the Department of Agriculture.

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Agriculture

- 19 (A) IF THE SECRETARY, AFTER CONSULTING THE LOCAL HEALTH
 20 AUTHORITY, FINDS THAT A PERSON IS CAUSING OR ALLOWING MOSQUITOES TO
 21 BREED OR DEVELOP ON ANY PROPERTY IN A MANNER THAT MAY POSE A THREAT
 22 TO PUBLIC HEALTH, THE SECRETARY MAY ORDER THAT THE PERSON ABATE
 23 THE MOSQUITO HABITAT IN A MANNER AND AT A TIME SPECIFIED IN THE
- 24 ORDER.



- 1 (B) AFTER ALL REASONABLE ATTEMPTS OF ABATEMENT HAVE FAILED,
- 2 AN ORDER ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION
- 3 SHALL BE SERVED:
- 4 (1) ON THE PERSON WHO IS CAUSING OR ALLOWING MOSQUITOES
- 5 TO BREED OR DEVELOP; OR
- 6 (2) If the person who is causing or allowing the
- 7 MOSQUITOES TO BREED OR DEVELOP CANNOT BE FOUND, ON THE OWNER OR
- 8 OCCUPANT OF THE PROPERTY WHERE THE MOSQUITOES EXIST.

- AFTER MAKING A REASONABLE ATTEMPT TO LOCATE THE OWNER OR
- 11 TENANT ON THE PREMISES FOR PERMISSION TO ENTER AND GIVING THE OWNER
- 12 OR TENANT A REASONABLE AMOUNT OF TIME TO RESPOND, THE SECRETARY
- 13 MAY ENTER ON AND INSPECT, AT ANY REASONABLE HOUR, ANY PRIVATE
- 14 PROPERTY, EXCLUDING A DWELLING, TO DETERMINE WHETHER MOSQUITOES
- 15 ARE BREEDING OR DEVELOPING.

- 17 (A) THE SECRETARY MAY BRING AN ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION
- 18 AGAINST ANY PERSON VIOLATING ANY ORDER ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY
- 19 UNDER § 5–406 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- 20 (B) IN ANY ACTION FOR AN INJUNCTION BROUGHT UNDER THIS
- 21 SECTION, ANY FINDING OF THE SECRETARY AFTER A HEARING SHALL BE PRIMA
- 22 FACIE EVIDENCE OF EACH FACT FOUND.
- 23 (C) ON A SHOWING BY THE SECRETARY THAT ANY PERSON IS
- 24 VIOLATING OR IS ABOUT TO VIOLATE ANY ORDER ISSUED BY THE SECRETARY,
- 25 AN INJUNCTION SHALL BE GRANTED WITHOUT THE NECESSITY OF SHOWING A
- 26 LACK OF ADEQUATE REMEDY AT LAW.
- 27 (D) AN INJUNCTION INSTITUTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE
- 28 ISSUED WITHOUT BOND.

- A PERSON WHO FAILS TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF AN
- 31 ORDER SERVED UNDER § 5-406 OF THIS SUBTITLE IS GUILTY OF A

- 1 MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING 2 \$5,000.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act does not increase the duties or responsibilities of local health authorities to engage in mosquito control activity.
- 6 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2010.
