BY adding to Article – Agriculture Section 10–1701 and 10–1702 to be under the new subtitle "Subtitle 17. Advertising or Identifying Agricultural Products as Locally Grown" Annotated Code of Maryland (2007 Replacement Volume and 2009 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Agriculture SUBTITLE 17. ADVERTISING OR IDENTIFYING AGRICULTURAL PRODUCTS AS LOCALLY GROWN.
