FOR the purpose of extending the hours on certain days when alcoholic beverages may
be sold for on-premises consumption in certain licensed establishments that
have been issued certain permits or are in a certain area of Baltimore City;
extending the hours on certain days when alcoholic beverages may be consumed
on the premises of certain licensed establishments in a certain area of
Baltimore City; and generally relating to the sale of alcoholic beverages in
Baltimore City.
